SUPPLY LIST

This is a list of the essentials. Feel free to bring other materials you'd like to use. If you are comfortable with the brands you use, stick with them. Art supplies are available at Dick Blick, Jerry's Artarama, Cheap Joes, and Amazon.

ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES

Acrylic Fluid Paints – Artist Grade - Golden, Utrecht, Blick, Davinci, Holbein

*If you have good artist quality tube paints, bring those as well. **Do not bring ONLY craft paints.** Invest in some professional quality colors. Bring at least the primary colors (yellow red and blue) or a variety of your favorite colors.*

1 tube of black and zinc white heavy body acrylic paint, any decent brand

Watercolor paints or gouache

Scissors, Exacto Knife,

Paint brushes include some inexpensive ones for acrylic work

Drawing materials such as pens, graphite pencils, markers, sticks,

Plastic gloves and protective clothing

Two water containers

Brayer or soup spoon

Roll of paper towels

OPTIONAL SUPPLIES

Pastels

Oil sticks-

Pastel sticks

Crayons

Stamps and stencils, old credit cards

Any textured surfaces you can find — ex: corrugated paper, rug liner, cheesecloth, doilies

Paper ephemera for personal use and to share

old book pages, gift wrap, newspaper, photocopies — any paper not too thick

***OTHER OPTIONAL PREPARATION**

If you would like to tint some inexpensive watercolor paper or other cheap paper ahead of time to include in your collage work it would be best to have it done ahead of time rather than doing it during the workshop. Saves time.

INSTRUCTORS WILL PROVIDE

11 x 14 gessoed hardboard panel - one per person

Acrylic medium for adhesion

Flat bristle brushes

Use of roller and sponges

Paper plate for palettes

Paper ephemera — old book pages, gift wrap, newspaper, assorted papers
