



49th ANNUAL JURIED EXHIBIT

The Trenton City Museum at Ellarslie

November 16, 2018 – January 27, 2019

Deadline for entries – October 21, 2018

The exhibition will be juried by internationally known New Jersey artist, James Toogood. Mr. Toogood, a long-time teacher at the Pennsylvania Academy of the Fine Arts, is a member of the AWS, NWS and AAA. His hyper realistic paintings have won numerous awards and he has been published in several art books and magazines.

Eligibility

- Open to all NJ, NY, PA and DE residents, artists 18 and over.
- Original water media (i.e., watercolor, acrylic, gouache, casein, egg tempera) on paper, Claybord or Yupo.
- Collage is acceptable if materials are created by the artist.
- Artist original work only. No paintings previously shown in any GSWS or Ellarslie exhibition.
- You may submit one or two images, but only one may be selected for exhibition.
- Diptychs and triptychs must be contained within 1 frame.
- Mats must be white or off-white. A small colored inner mat is acceptable.
- Hand delivery of accepted works only.
- Minimum painting size is 9" x 12".
- Frame size must be no larger than 60" in height or width.
- All artwork 36" or larger must be framed under Plexiglass.
- All artwork must be wired and ready to hang.
- GSWS reserves the right to disqualify an entry for any reason, including but not limited to, poorly matted or framed work or work that is not presented professionally.

About your digital image – digital format (online and mail)

- Digital file must be in JPEG format, file size up to 3MB.
- For best presentation, try to save your image with a dpi of 300 with 1200 pixels on the longer side.
- The image must be correctly oriented (vertical or horizontal).
- Show only the image, no mat or frame.
- No digital enhancement is allowed. Work must not differ from the artist's digitally accepted image.
- Name the image file: artist's name, submission 1 or 2, and title of painting. Please follow this format: smith.jane1_title.jpg; smith.jane2_title.jpg.

Entry Fees

- GSWS Members (with 2018 dues paid) \$15 for 1st submission, \$25 for 2 submissions
- Non-Members* \$35 for 1st submission, \$45 for 2 submissions

*Non-Members will be granted GSWS membership for 2019 with their paid entry fee. This will allow artists to participate in the annual GSWS members show, the GSWS Art Sale, and other GSWS events.

All entry fees are non-refundable. Payment must be made at the time of your online entry with credit or debit card or with a check if submitting by mail.

Entry Procedures

- Submit by one method only. Online is preferred.
- Entries must be submitted online or postmarked no later than midnight, October 21, 2018.

- Save digital image on a CD.
- Label the CD with the artist's name using permanent marker.
- Include a completed entry form provided below.
- Include a check for the entry fee.

All artwork must be for sale and be available for the duration of the exhibition. Ellarslie and GSWS will split a 40% sales commission. A check will be sent to the artist within 30 days after the close of the exhibition.
