

## Round Robin Painting Event 2019

Thank you for agreeing to participate in a Round Robin Painting Event that is being sponsored by GSWS. Please see the explanation below.

**When and where?** On Sunday, October 27, 2019 from 1:30 – 4:00 PM – during the GSWS Juried Exhibit at the AOY Art Center, Yardley PA.

**Who will be participating?** Angela Barbalace, Diane Kosco, Tess Fields and Aida Birriteri

**Why is GSWS holding such an event?** The idea for this came from a GSWS member that attended such an event held by the Florida Watercolor Society during their annual convention. We anticipate that the event will engage artists and the general public alike, raise funds for GSWS and AOY Art Center, bring people into the ongoing exhibit and will encourage more artists to join our organization.

**What is a Round Robin Painting Event?** Four artists will paint four paintings in a collaborative, lively two+ hour event. This is the way it works:

- Each participating GSWS artist will bring the following:
  - Their paints
  - Their brushes and other painting equipment
  - A standing or table easel
  - Watercolor paper/board prepared for painting a 18 x 20 inch painting
  - A pencil sketch on the sheet and masking as needed
  - Reference photos for the painting

Note: GSWS will pay each artist \$50

- Setting up the painting stations
  - In the down stairs galleries each artist will set up using a table and chair that will be provided at each painting station
  - If you have one or more lamps please bring them.
- Then the fun begins:
  - At 1:30, each artist will begin to paint on the paper/board that they have prepared
  - After 15 minutes, each painting/board will move to the next artist
  - The paintings/boards will proceed every 15 minutes until they are back at the station where they started
  - Each artist will have 15 minutes or so to complete the painting
- Audience participation
  - While the painting is going on we will sell “raffle-type” tickets
  - There will be one box for the raffle tickets for each artist at the sale table
  - The audience members will put one or more tickets into one or more boxes

- Completing the event
  - The paintings will be put into a mat that is provided by GSWS and the completed paintings will be displayed
  - We will pick one winner from each box
  - The winners will take the painting home with them!
  
- Please note: Paintings generated from the round robin event are collaborative in nature and a product of GSWS. All participating artists will sign each painting. Paintings will not be presented as a single artist's work product.
